# What is governance for HRH?

- Some definitions
  - Setting strategic direction and objectives
  - Making the policies, laws, rules, regulations, decisions and raising/deploying resources to accomplish strategic goals and objectives
  - Making sure that strategic goals and objectives are accomplished
- Dynamic and adaptive

## Aspects of global governance for HRH

- Pervasive
- Generates evidence through research
- Ensures accountability—keeps score
- Engages politically
- Creates strategies and plans
- Encourages dialogue among countries
- Encourages multisectoral action
  - Across health sector functions (\$, services, supplies)
  - Across development sectors
