Call for Abstract For the 11th AAAH Conference

The Asia-Pacific Action Alliance on Human Resources for Health (AAAH) is organizing the 11th AAAH conference in Yangon, Myanmar, from the 10th to the 12th of August 2020. The theme of this Conference is "Accelerate Progress towards Achievement of 2020 and Actions for 2030 Milestones of Global Strategy on HRH".

This conference aims to update the 2nd review of the WHO Global Code of Practice on the International Recruitment of Health Personnel and its progress from each AAAH member. There will also review the achievements of 2020 milestones, address on challenges and potential solutions as well as discuss on concrete plans for 2030 milestones.

PARTICIPATION

The participants will be drawn from the 18 AAAH member countries, as well as from other countries, in particular those within Asia Pacific region. It is anticipated that around 150-200 participants will attend the conference, representing various interest groups such as the Ministry of Health, professionals, academia, government organizations, non-government organizations, the private sectors, and international agencies.

Format A: Case Study (Abstract: Must include introduction, objective, methods, results, conclusion(s), and policy implications)

Format B: Research Study (Abstract: Must include introduction, objective, methods, results, conclusion(s), and policy implications)

Note: the abstract should present in poster format (60 X 90 cm). If the abstract shows the relevant value in accordance with the agenda of the conference, the owner of original work may be invited to take part in as a presenter in the relevant sessions.
